TAX CREDIT SPECIFICATIONS

For Natural Gas Water Heaters

All ENERGY STAR tankless water heaters

For Natural Gas Furnaces

AFUE \geq 95

For Natural Gas Boilers

AFUE \geq 90

Note: An Energy Star rating does not necessarily mean furnaces and boilers qualify. Use the AFUE rating listed here.

AVAILABLE CREDIT FOR EACH:

30% of cost, up to \$1,500 (Subject to a \$1,500 maximum per homeowner for all improvements combined.)

About The Energy Improvement and Extension Act of 2008 (H.R. 1424: Div. B, Sec. 302) and The American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (H.R. 1: Div. B, Sec. 1121):

“The credit applies to energy efficiency improvements in the building envelope of existing homes and for the purchase of high-efficiency heating, cooling and water-heating equipment. Efficiency improvements or equipment must serve a dwelling in the United States that is owned and used by the taxpayer as a primary residence. The maximum amount of homeowner credit for all improvements combined is \$1,500 for equipment purchased during the two-year period of 2009 and 2010.”
